

Claims Submitted to FTA - IT Liability



Data Corruption Due to Power Outage

A power outage resulted in data corruption, revealing that an adequate backup solution was not in place. The insured claimed they were not properly informed by the third party about the backup solution required to prevent such an issue.

Claim Payout: \$150,000 (including defence costs)



Incorrect Artwork Provided by Graphic Designer

The insured, a graphic designer, created a file for a client that contained incorrect information and artwork, which was then printed. As a result, the client requested a refund for the printing costs.

Claim Payout: \$28,000



Key Man Loss Due to Director's Passing

The insured experienced a key man loss when the Director passed away. As a result, the insured had to cover the recruitment costs of finding a new Director.

Claim Payout: \$50,000



Infringement of Intellectual Property

The insured, an IT company, was accused of infringing on a competitor's intellectual property by using patented software in one of their products without proper licensing. The competitor filed a lawsuit, and the insured was required to cover legal fees, settlement costs, and licensing fees for the software.

Claim Payout: \$120,000
